



Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Agreement (2017)

I want my child to bring their own digital device to school for use to support their learning at Heaton.

I understand (please tick each statement):

- All devices brought to school are my child's responsibility and the insurance for the device is my responsibility.
- All classrooms will have lockable spaces in which my child may place their device when not in use. This will be your child's responsibility.
- The school holds no responsibility for any loss or damage which might occur.
- Children bring devices to school each day fully charged. Charging at school is not available.
- Apps and software on devices must be kept up to date, particularly anti virus software as applicable.
- Devices are only to be used under adult supervision.
- Devices brought to school are to be used by my child. The school adheres to a 'sharing screen' concept, whereby my child may share his/her screen with others. In collaborative group work there may be 2-3 children working together, however my child is in charge of his/her device.
- Children will use cloud based applications such as Google Drive for file management and are allowed to access this at home with parent permission.
- Rules governing the use of any school-owned digital device will apply to student-owned devices while they are at school. This includes adherence to the Copyright Act and School Digital Citizenship policies. This is in accordance with our Responsible ICT User Agreements.
